

**IDAHO HORSE COUNCIL**  
**EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**  
**High School Students**  
*Information and General Requirements*

The Idaho Horse Council, a non-profit association, is composed of organizations across the state involved in the equine industry. In 1999, the council's Board of Directors voted to fund up to three scholarships annually. Scholarships are being offered for the current school year for graduates of Idaho High Schools. The IHC reserves the right to vary the number of scholarships awarded based on the entries as scored by the judges, and funds available. Scholarship applications must be received at the Idaho Horse Council office by **April 10, 2026**. No youth that is a member of the immediate family of an officer, member of the Board of Directors, or paid personnel of the Idaho Horse Council will be eligible.

1. Applicants must be either a member of an Idaho Horse Council affiliate or the Idaho Youth Horse Council.
2. Applicants must be legal residents of the State of Idaho.
3. Applicants for the current school year must graduate or have graduated from an accredited Idaho High School.
4. Applicants must be involved in equine and/or the equine industry.
5. Applications must be completely filled out and signed by the applicant and applicant's parents/guardian.
6. An original, 8" x 10", black and white, full face (portrait) photo of the applicant must accompany the application. Pictures and applications become the property of the Idaho Horse Council and will not be returned. **Photos of recipients will be posted on the IHC website.**
7. It is to each applicant's advantage to submit a complete, neat, accurate, and informative application because of the competition and skills of all the applicants. Copies of email correspondence are not acceptable. Scholarship applications may be either mailed to 16114 Idaho Center Blvd. #5, Nampa, Idaho 83687, or hand delivered to the Idaho Horse Council office during regular office hours and received on or before **April 10, 2025**.
